Democrats Secure Millions in Funding to Strengthen Public Safety



While Republicans claim that Democrats want to defund the police, House and Senate Democrats have secured nearly \$400 million this year to fund public safety projects in their districts and states. Republicans secured around \$272 million. This funding will go toward hiring and training law enforcement, upgrading police equipment and forensic technology, improving funding violence intervention and youth outreach programs, improving mental health and substance use services, and more. 150 House Democrats Sent Public Safety Funding to Their Districts

In the 2024 Omnibus Appropriations Bill, 150 House Democrats earmarked over \$210 million for public safety initiatives in their district. These funds are being used to hire and train law enforcement officers, upgrade police equipment and technology, fund violence intervention and youth outreach programs, provide victim support services, and more. 

46 Senate Democrats Sent Public Safety Funding to Their States

In the 2024 Omnibus Appropriations Bill, 46 Senate Democrats earmarked over \$253 million for public safety initiatives in their state. These funds are being used to upgrade police communications networks, provide body cameras to law enforcement, fund mental health and substance use services, improve forensic technology, and more.
