Accountability	Prohibits the police union from bargaining the disciplinary process, making it easier to fire officers accused of misconduct	Bars officers from qualified immunity, making it easier to bring charges against offending officers
Training	Requires officer training on de- escalation and use of force	Requires law enforcement officers to complete training on racial profiling, implicit bias, and duty to intervene
